This year JAAP is celebrating its 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, Alhumdulliah.

The objective friendly ties and cooperation between Pakistan and Japan; develop contacts with JICA and various training institutions in



Japan with a view to exchange information of mutual benefit and to promote transfer of technical knowhow among the members.
